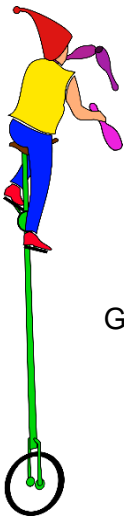

7. All Children's entries must be the unaided work of the child.

11. Exhibits not claimed by 4.45 p.m. will be auctioned.
12. The Judges may withhold prizes, at their discretion, if the exhibits are not of sufficient standard, or there are less than three in any class.

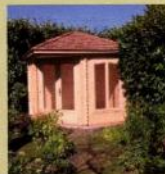
